FROM CWU REGIONAL SAFETY REPS

We last wrote in the summer, when we had ended the lock down. Then along came wave #2...

With pressure, it has been such a busy time, some offices with 20+ staff away with Covid or self-isolating, 30+ staff, 40+ staff, some temporarily closed completely. Plus there's a new variant lurking about.





But there is hope, since Summer there is a now a vaccine. The nation's NHS and health care workers and almost all of the nation's over 80YO's have been vaccinated. Despite reports with international and European supplies, it's still refreshing to know that some of the vaccines are made in Britain. But the queues are still long, it may take months.

Plus since the summer virus testing is much improved, many MC's process over 4000 kits home testing per dayⁱ, there are easy access drive through NHS test centres. For the alternative linear and lateral flow tests, local town walk-in centres, plus after Sheffield MC piloted a 'walk-in' workplace test centre, that is now being rolled out, with the next being set-up in Birmingham MC. Access to a test was never this easy during the first wave.

We wanted to talk with you again. With some fresh stuff about best protecting yourself, your workmates, your income and your family. Last time we said, there's been so much written and said, it's very confusing.

The Facts:

Covid-19 is not Flu. It is a virus like the Common Cold.

Unlike bacteria, some of which are beneficial to humans. Practically all viruses are harmful, debilitating and potentially deadly to humans, much like conspiracy theory.

Who remembers Zika Virus in 2015? Not fatal, in fact very mild symptoms. But which affected significant numbers of births, causing defects and brain deformations.

Since November Covid-19 deaths have <u>doubled</u> in the UK.



Let us try and put that in perspective for you.

- The total number UK civilian deaths in WW2 was 67,000ⁱⁱ. Fact.
- The UK Covid mortality figure is in excess of 103,000 deaths.
 (in just 1 year)
- WW2 in the UK from Summer 1939 to Summer 1945 lasted
 6 years. Fact.

Worse than that (ongoing) hospital admissions due to Covid-19 have been over 380,000, with 39,000 admissions/beds occupied this last week.

The NHS has come close to failure, with typically most wards being set aside, specifically for this disease.

Triage in some units is close to condemning patients to certain death.

With a further number of people, colleagues and family members struggling and agonising in their own homes, in some cases for several weeks, needing care, meds, and oxygen. That figure above, does not come even close to the actual reality.



So, are we coming out of this second wave?
